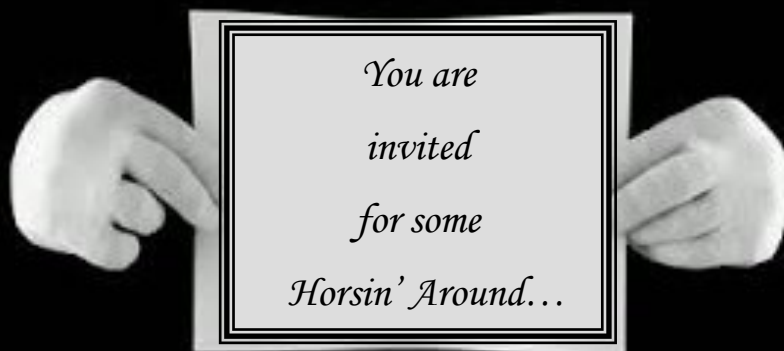


Calling all women in the Gwydir Shire
